MONTGOMERY COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, can confirm there are now 438 ACTIVE cases of COVID-19. That number includes 49 hospitalizations. 152 people have fully recovered. The number of total positive cases has increased 20 since yesterday to 602.

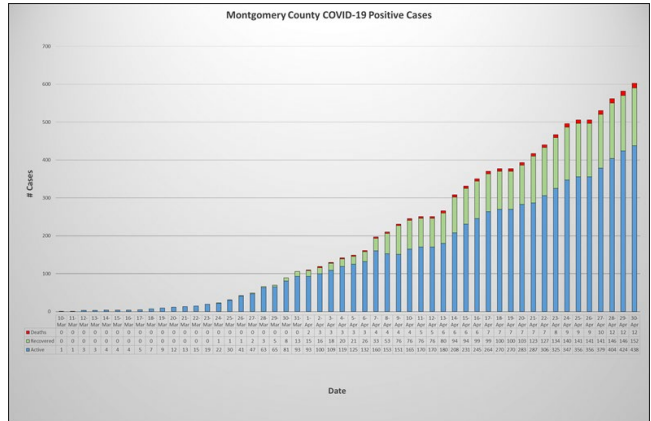
