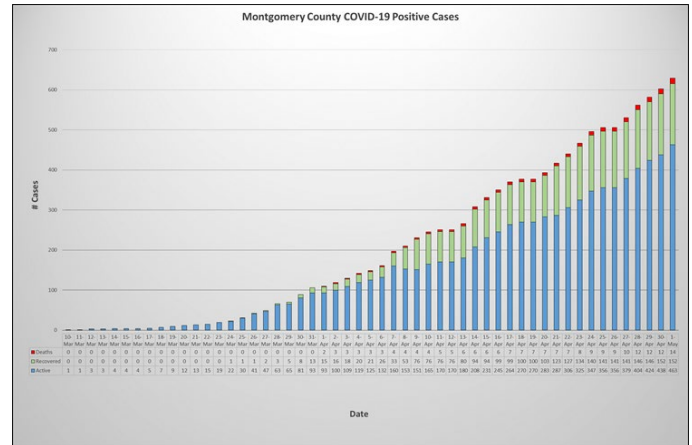
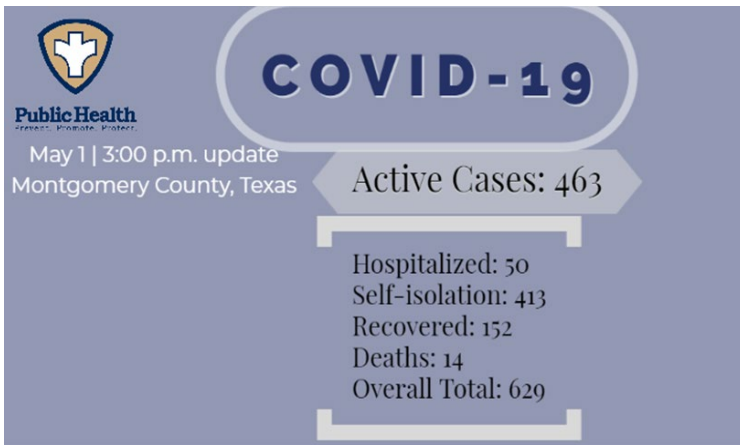
MONTGOMERY COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, is saddened to confirm our 13th and 14th deaths related to COVID-19. A woman in her 60s, from Conroe, died in a local hospital. Also, a man in his 90s, from Porter, died in a long-term care facility.

We can also confirm there are now 463 ACTIVE cases of COVID-19. That number includes 50 hospitalizations. 152 people have fully recovered. The number of total positive cases has increased 27 since yesterday to 629.
