MONTGOMERY COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, can confirm there are now 467 ACTIVE cases of COVID-19. That number includes 51 hospitalizations. 153 people have fully recovered. The number of total positive cases has increased 5 since yesterday to 634.

Due to the low number of test results we receive on Saturdays, we will no longer be providing updates on the weekends. We are reallocating our staff to the busiest reporting days which are Monday through Friday.

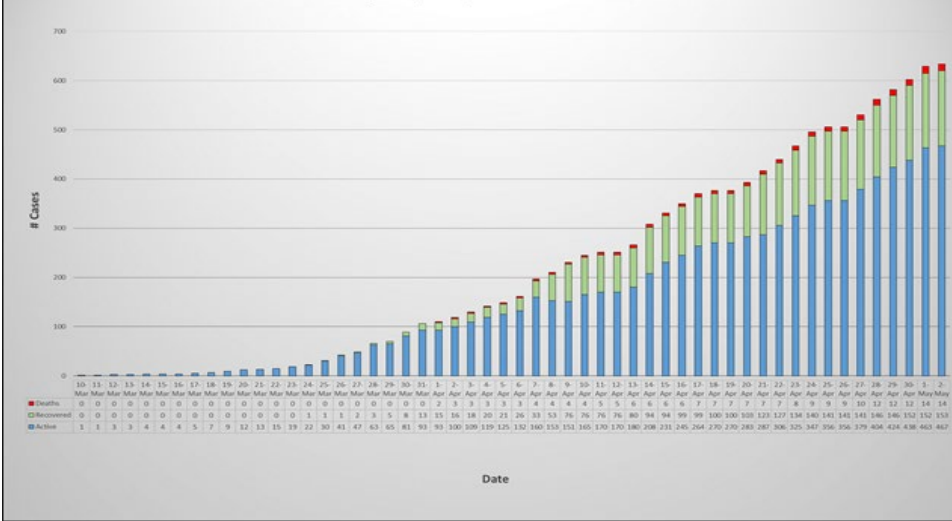
