## **MONTGOMERY COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE**


MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, can confirm our 16<sup>th</sup> death related to COVID-19. A woman in her 100s died at Park Manor of Conroe, a long-term care facility. We offer our condolences to her family at this difficult time.


We can also confirm the number of ACTIVE cases of COVID-19 has increased to 429 today. That number includes 54 hospitalizations. 254 people have fully recovered! The number of total positive cases has increased 10 since yesterday to 699.

A mobile testing clinic will be in our area this Sunday, May 10<sup>th</sup>. The tests are by appointment only. See the attached flyer for more details.
