MONTGOMERY COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, is saddened to confirm two additional deaths related to COVID-19. The first is a woman in her 50s from Conroe. The second case is a woman in her 60s from Conroe. Both were hospitalized when they died. We offer our condolences to both families at this time.

We can also confirm the number of ACTIVE cases of COVID-19 has decreased to 461 today. That number includes 26 hospitalizations. 439 people have fully recovered. The number of total positive cases has increased 13 since yesterday to 926.

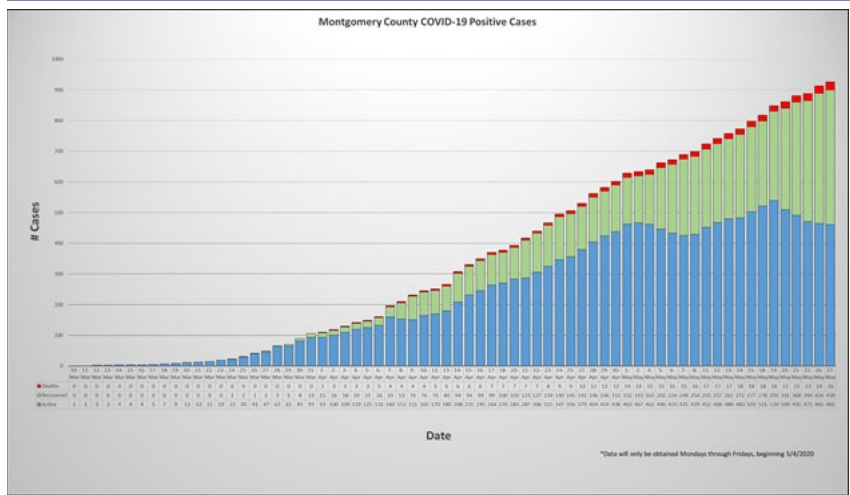
