MONTGOMERY COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with the Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, can confirm the following update regarding COVID-19:

- TOTAL cases of COVID-19 increased by 72 to 5,852 since yesterday's report.
- ACTIVE cases of COVID-19 decreased by 47 to 2,550 since yesterday's report.
- 63 residents are known to be in the hospital, as a result of contact investigations. Contact investigations have not been initiated on all reported cases.
- 3,140 people have clinically recovered.


