#### MONTGOMERY COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with the Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, can confirm three additional deaths related to COVID-19. Two men in their 80s, both from Montgomery, and a woman in her 80s, from Willis, have died. All had co-morbidities in addition to testing positive for COVID-19.

We can also confirm the following:

- TOTAL cases of COVID-19 increased by 138 to 5,990 since yesterday's report.
- ACTIVE cases of COVID-19 decreased by 7 to 2,543 since yesterday's report.
- 68 residents are known to be in the hospital, as a result of contact investigations. Contact investigations have not been initiated on all reported cases.
- 3,285 people have clinically recovered.


