## MONTGOMERY COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with the Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, can confirm the following update related to COVID-19.

- TOTAL cases of COVID-19 increased by 400 to 21.608 since vesterday's (12/14) report. All 400 new cases were tested since 12/01/2020.
- ACTIVE cases of COVID-19 increased by 124 to 5,425 since yesterday's (12/14) report. On Tuesdays, we factor in additional "inactive" cases who we have been unable to contact for more
  than 30 days. Today, we added 148 additional inactive cases.
- 33 residents are known, as a result of contact investigations, to be in the hospital. Contact investigations have not been initiated on all reported cases.
- 12,394 people have clinically recovered.


